TIME: 0830 Show Time, Match Starts at 0900

FACILITY: The outdoor pistol range has covered shooting positions. There is no running water. Portable toilets are available. If required, local COVID-19 procedures will be followed. Recommend competitors bring a cooler with cold drinks.

REGISTRATION AND MATCH FEE: Online registration and payment of match fee available at the SHOT website. Sport pistol slot assignment available at <https://www.signupgenius.com/go/5080e44acae22abfe3-2021>. Signup for only one slot. There are 20 slots available each day 9-10 July.

RULES: The current International Shooting Sport Federation rules will govern. For equal cumulative scores, ties will be broken using the total number of Xs. If scores are still tied, the highest total score of the last 10 competitive rapid fire shots will be used. Eye and hearing protection are mandatory. Competitors should have a clear barrel indicator for their pistol.

COURSE OF FIRE: There is only one match per competitor. No finals will be conducted.

- Precision Stage, 30 shots, one sighting shots series, six competition shots series.
- Rapid-Fire Stage, 30 shots, one sighting shots series, six competition shots series, from ready position, seven seconds edged, three seconds faced.

RELAY START TIME: Show time is 0830. Start time is 0900.

PISTOL: .22 long rifle caliber pistol, **metallic sights only, no fiber or optic sights.**

DISTANCE: 25 yards

TARGETS AND SCORING: Targets will be replaced after the sighting shots series and after ten competition shots. Targets will be manually scored. (NRA B19 and NRA B38).

COACHING: Coaching on the firing line will not be permitted.

PROTESTS: After preliminary scores are posted, competitors will have 15 minutes to review their targets and address any concerns with the match director. The match director will refer protests to the target jury for decision. After the protest period, scores are final and will not be changed.

RESULTS: Preliminary and final results will be posted at the official's tent.

AWARDS: SASP will provide awards.
