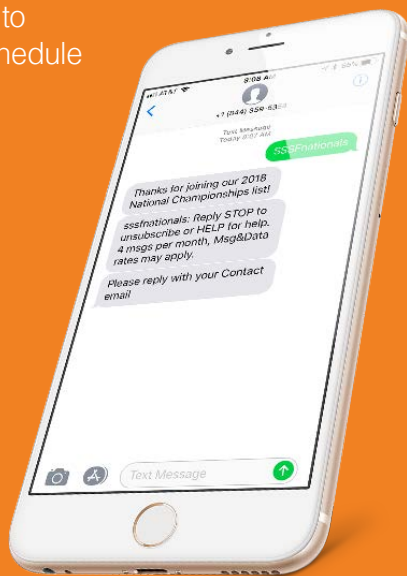

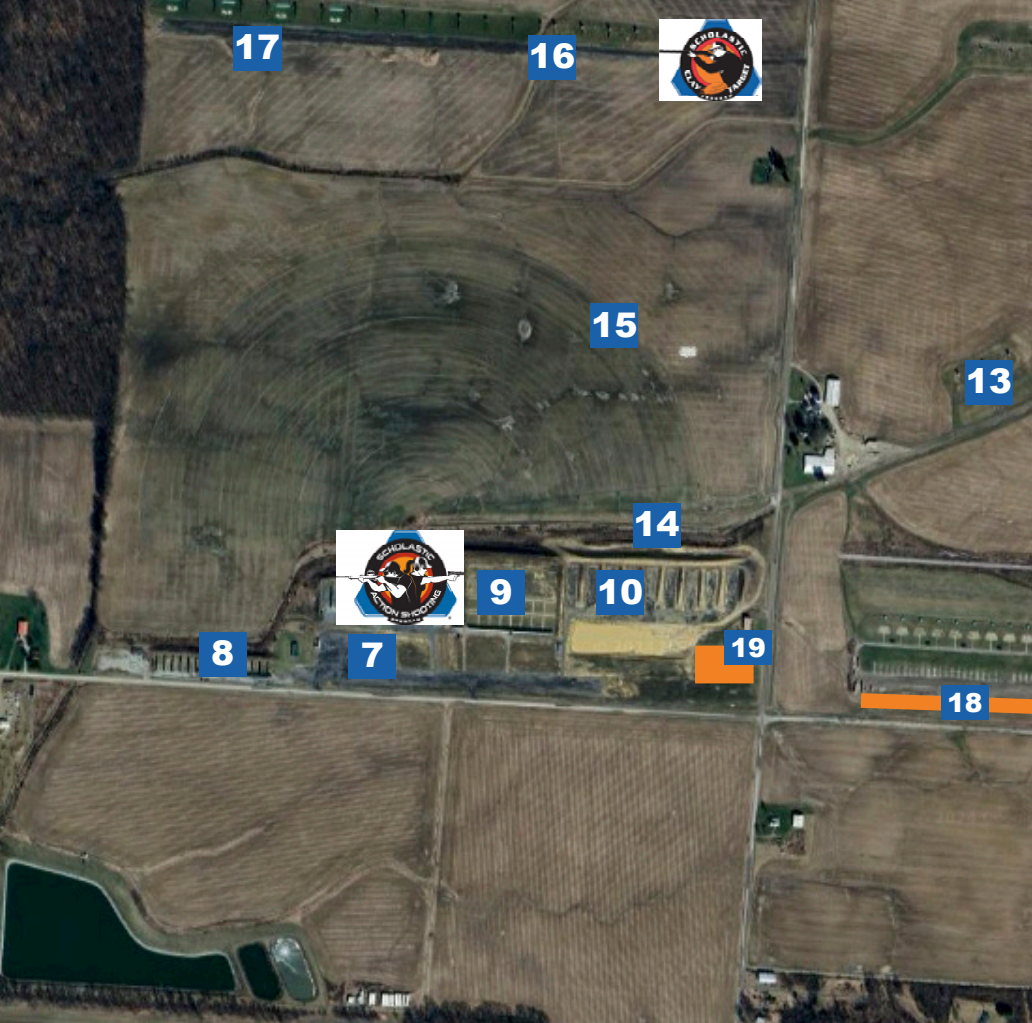

Registration

All coaches will be required to sign off on their team's squadding, verifying that all squads and divisions are correct! Team and athlete event registration fees may be refunded through July 1st.

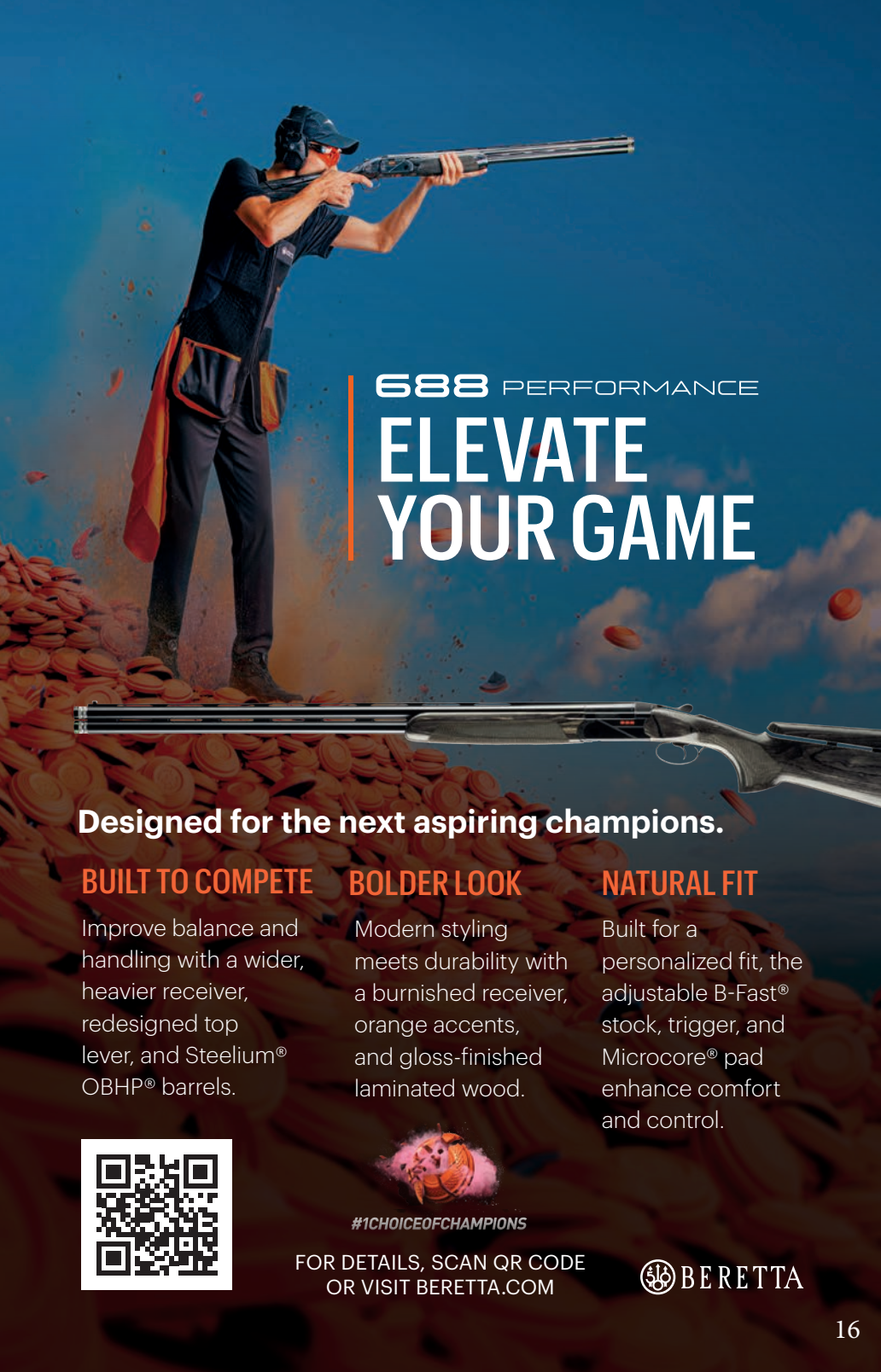
Collegiate - Athletes must have been enrolled as full time students in an accredited college/university during the 2025-26 school year.

Shoot Off Procedure:

Shoot off procedure is listed in the handbook. The only shoot offs will be for perfect scores or HOA ties. Athletes and Coaches will be notified through the text system if they are needed for a shoot off.

Note:

Shoot times will be strictly enforced. Please do not waste time in between rounds, and NO coaching is allowed during or between rounds.

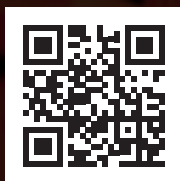

Caledon Shotguns

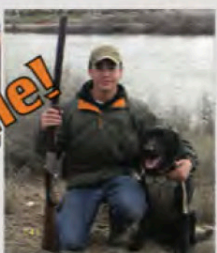

magazine does for the junior shooters out there and hope that I can continue to get permission shooting for the future. About six months ago I had a pair of SAUCO Canadian Gun and Order (CAG) shotguns for \$9 each, a 12 gauge and a South Model 20 gauge. I have since shot both many times and have really enjoyed doing so. The standard 12 gauge model features a 34 1/2" length of pull, automatic, ejector, magazine feed, and a single selector knob. The highest quality Turkish wanted is meticulously shaped, oiled, and hand finished to perfection. All models are offered in a 27", 28", or 30" barrel. The 12 gauge model weighs 7.25 pounds, while the 20 gauge weighs a modest 6.5 pounds. The Caledon features well on opening clay courses and comes well in the field. Many classic and timeless qualities make the Caledon unique among others in the field. The Youth Caledon has a barrel length of 27", a 12 1/2" length of pull and weighs only

hand and very steady. The birds like it where they think there are safe from bullets, which is really nice from my angle. Loaded the 12 gauge and absolutely loved it! It was great for the difficult terrain. Before you take off the long and use all your energy to get to where you want to be, which is at the top of the bank, you want your gun to perform flawlessly. The 12 gauge passed with flying colors.

Ease of assembly: The two 12 gauge were a snap to put together and came apart equally fast had a very tight action. A tight action is important if you want your gun to last a long time, which these guns will.

How it felt in my hands: The guns felt great in my hands, and I really enjoyed shooting them both. The 12 gauge fit me perfectly and shot right where I wanted it to. It was really smooth to shoot and easy to swing in a moving bird or target. The barrel was just long enough that you wouldn't miss anything

upland birds and had great success with both of them for a day of pleasant hunting with my friends. One of the hunting was very successful, and I had a very nice day. One of the things that I really enjoyed about the hunt was that the birds were so close that I could see them clearly. I was really happy that they would be so close to me. Another great aspect of these guns is the versatility. You could use them for almost anything. From the clay disciplines (opening clay, short trap) to game game, even to waterfowl, they are an all-around great gun. I took the 20 gauge hunting many times for quail and doves and loved using it. Both guns were so beautiful and at the same time rugged and reliable.

The promise of happiness for a shotgun is shorter hunting, it is probably the most challenging form of land hunting, but also the most rewarding. Chucker is other

short enough that it could be swung quickly to get a fast-moving object. The weight was not too heavy. It was nice to carry around all day. The 20 gauge was also fun to shoot. It was really smooth to shoot and easy to swing in a moving bird or target. The barrel was just long enough that you wouldn't miss anything

Right: Each gun had a huge brass bead at the end of its barrel which was great. You could see birds and targets with great ease. The field of view was enough that you could see where you were shooting and the target at the same time. I would not change the sight picture at all.

Beats: The most was noticeable but manageable. Both light target loads and heavy game loads were fine to shoot through the gun, and with the interchangeable chokes tubes, you could adjust the pattern of the gun if you wanted to.

Safety: The guns had a safety on the top of the receiver: it was a mechanical safety, so you have to turn it off every time you close the gun. This is great for land hunting, which are what these guns are really made for, but not so much for shooting clay targets. The safety was easy to get to and turn off when it was time to shoot.

These guns were great, and I would not change anything about either of them. They were awesome in every respect, and had a blast trying them out!

Thanks again, Junior Shooters, for allowing me to write an article for you.

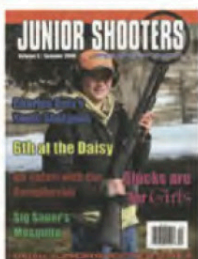

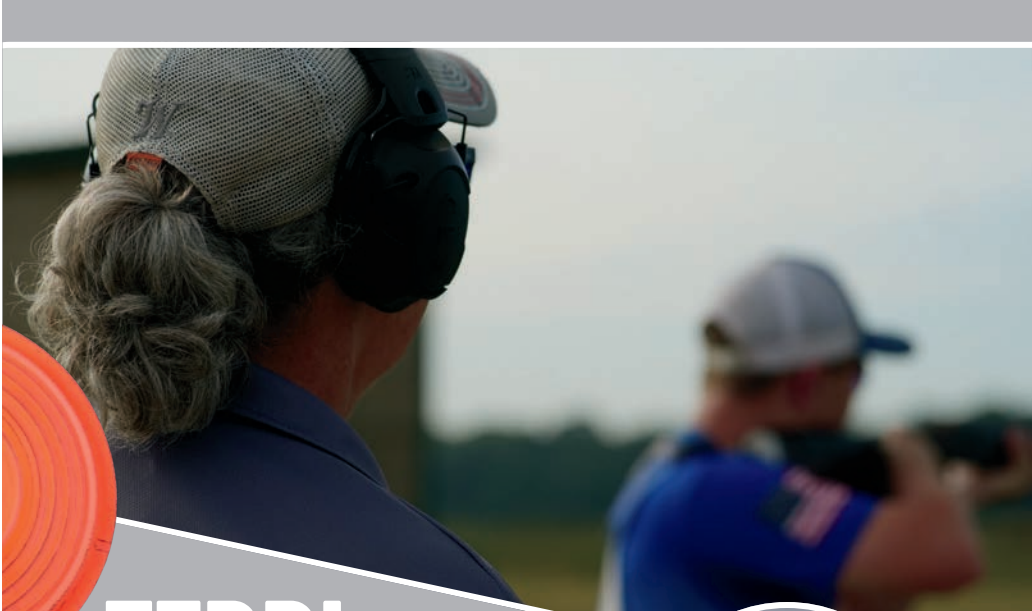

2026 CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT

To highlight the relationship between the coach, the players and amongst the players themselves, here is how a Coach and Players Team work together in a Best-of-Three game MATCH:

1. The two Team Coaches in a match come to the *Make-A-Break* stages with their 5 players
2. The referee flips a coin and selects a coach, who then calls the flip. If the coach wins, she/he has the choice of putting up their first 2 players, OR making the other coach put up their first 2 players. This determines which stage a team shoots from (left or right) and which team starts the game - left side always shoots first
3. In the first half of each game and prior to commencing, each Team Coach chooses a player to shoot even numbered targets and the other to shoot odd numbered targets. In the second half the coach chooses the target numbers for each player as well:
 - a. There are 10 pairs of targets in a round, with 6 pairs in the first half and 4 pairs in the second half
 - b. Each team player must shoot at 3 pairs in the first half and 2 pairs in the second half of each round
 - c. Team players shoot their pairs alternately with each other
 - d. Coaches are responsible for getting their players on and off the stage and in the correct position
 - e. Each coach is responsible for watching the scoreboard and understanding the game and the number of points needed to win
4. The teams swap stages and now each coach selects 2 different players from the remaining 3 and shoots Game Two in the same format as Game One

2026 QUALIFYING SCORES

Here is the format SCTP Team Coaches must follow for the official 2026 *Make-A-Break* TEAM CHAMPIONSHIP event:

1. Teams must register with the SCTP SHOT system before they can attempt to qualify for the Team Championship
2. Teams consist of 5 players and 1 Team Coach
3. Qualifying will be shot on one of the two *Make-A-Break* fields on the Main Trap Line.
4. Qualifying for this event begins on Saturday, July 11th and ends at 4:00 pm on Thursday, July 16th
5. There is no limit to the number of qualifying attempts a team can make
6. To qualify, each team player will shoot one game of *Make-A-Break*
 - a) Two team players will each shoot one game, followed by another 2 team players, followed by the remaining 1 team player
 - b) The 5 individual scores will be combined, and 325 points is a perfect team score
 - c) If there are tied scores, a shoot-off will be done using pairs of targets at the referee's discretion to determine the top 8 teams
 - d) Team Coaches are encouraged to be on the stage to provide advice to their team players while they are shooting
7. The top 4 teams from each qualification field will be in the Championship Final, and a team can only hold one place in the Final
8. The Team Coach is responsible for getting the players on and off the stage and into the correct shooting position for each game

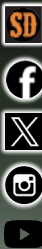

- UNRULY guests will be asked to leave the premises.

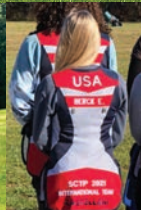

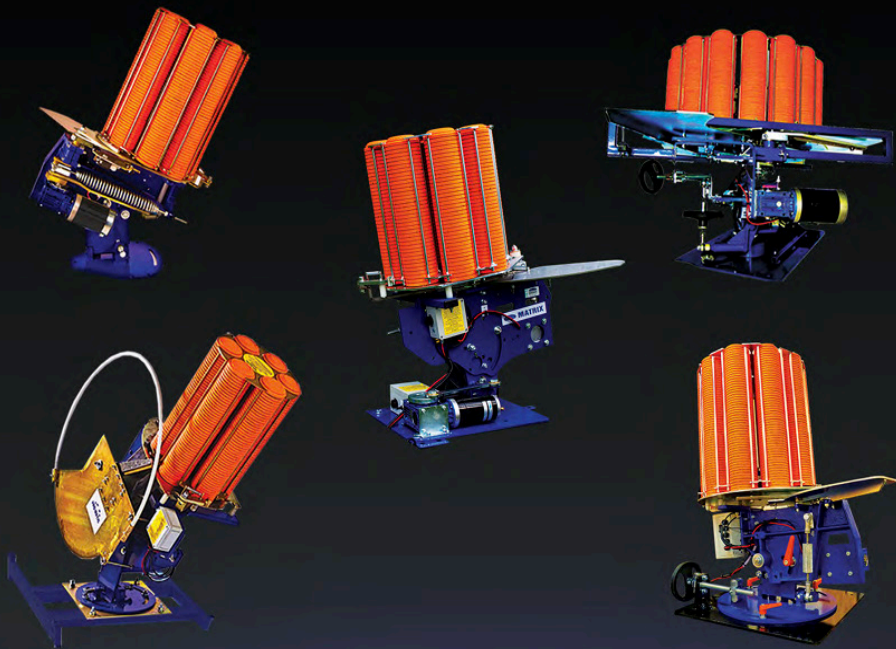
ADDITIONAL GUIDELINES FOR SCTP & SASP

1. Current ATA, NSCA, NSSA, USA Shooting and SASP rules, as well as rules in this program and any match or National Director's bulletins posted on this range, govern this match.
2. All participating athletes and coaches must be registered and fully paid with the SSSF before competing. Event registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. For SCTP and SASP, all reservations will be done electronically through the team login at www.sssfonline.org.
3. All ammunition and practice rounds are the responsibility of the participant.
4. Alcohol/illegal or individually non-prescribed drugs and firearms do not mix. Alcohol and other illegal substances are strictly forbidden by the SSSF during this event. Further, any person who is found to be in possession of, or under the influence of, alcohol or drugs while using, cleaning, maintaining, inspecting, or otherwise handling their shotgun or any other firearm at any time will be immediately disqualified from the entire event and asked to leave without refund.
5. Safe gun handling and appropriate shooting attire are required. Flip-flops and open-toed/ heeled shoes are prohibited. **Tops:** Shirt must have sleeves. Items of clothing that expose any part of the torso are prohibited. These include, but are not limited to, cutoff T-shirts, halter tops, tank tops, etc. **Bottoms:** Short shorts and low riding shorts or pants revealing undergarments or buttocks are prohibited.
6. **Hat Shooting is strictly prohibited during this event.** Any Competitor or coach who participates in hat shooting will be immediately disqualified and asked to leave the competition without refund.
7. All athletes must sign the score sheet (next to the score total) before leaving the range.
8. Use of any tobacco product by anyone under the age of 18 is against Ohio State Law, and any use of tobacco product by an SCTP/SASP participant is against SSSF guidelines. Participating in the use of tobacco products can be grounds for disqualification from the tournament.
9. Any athlete or adult disqualified from the tournament will not receive a refund of any tournament fees, game fees, practice fees or any other funds paid to SSSF or its agents.
10. SASP ties will be broken per rule book. If a tie occurs for final ranking, the In & Out stage score will be used as the tie-breaker. If that does not break the tie, the fastest single run of that stage will be used as the tie-breaker. If still needed, the second and third run will be used as the tie breaker.
